Registration Information

HIGH SCHOOL

On-line registration is available for Health, PE, and Computer Lit. ONLY.

High School Summer School **core courses** are open **ONLY** for remediation. Students are required to submit a copy of a current report card or transcript showing an F for the class in which they hope to enroll. **Mail-in registration only from March through April.** Walk-In Registration dates will be posted on the website (www.washoe.k12.nv.us/suppcredit) for May and June. Mail-in registration will be taken first.

March 9 **CURRENT** seniors and juniors **ONLY**

March 30 **current** sophomores and freshmen may begin registering

April 6 Graduating 8th graders may begin registering for Computer Lit., Health, or PE

MIDDLE SCHOOL

On-line registration opens April 6.

Mail-in will be accepted but on-line registration will have first chance at location preferences. Walk-In Registration dates will be posted on the website (www.washoe.k12.nv.us/suppcredit) for May and June.

PLATO Math and Language Arts only.

Students sign up for ONE 2-hour period ONLY. Students may complete as many courses as needed (one at a time) during the six-week session. Students may stop attending as soon as they have completed the required courses they need to complete to move to the next grade level. New students may enroll whenever an opening appears on the website.

If PLATO courses are incomplete at the end of the six-week session, the student may be able to continue the course at the zoned school in September. A student may complete both math and language arts during the six-week session at no additional cost. The student will be enrolled first in whichever subject the counselor feels is most needed. Once that course is completed, the student will ask the teacher to be enrolled in the next course.

Since PLATO is completed mostly on a computer, the student is NOT to be enrolled in more than ONE two-hour period.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

On-line registration opens April 6.

Mail-in will be accepted but on-line registration will have first chance at location preferences.

Walk-In Registration dates will be posted on the website (www.washoe.k12.nv.us/suppcredit) for May and June.

Enroll the student in the grade level the student is CURRENTLY attending. Summer School is designed for REMEDIATION, not for acceleration.

Summer School 2009 Changes

High School Registration for core subjects must be mailed in with a copy of transcript or report card showing the course being requested has been failed.

High School ONLINE registration is available for PE/Sports, Health, and Computer Lit ONLY. These are the same courses that rising 9th graders will be allowed to take. **Online registration in these classes will get first choice.**

Requests for exceptions for **high school** enrollment must be made by the counselor (NOT the parent) to Juanita Ydiando. If approved, a copy of her e-mail must be attached to the student's registration form in place of the transcript or report card.

Middle and Elementary Summer School is available for ONLINE Registration.
Online registration will get first choice of classes.

Middle Summer School will be held for six weeks and students will be allowed to enroll in only ONE two-hour period. No direct instruction. All students will be using PLATO.

Elementary Summer School will remain a four-week program and will be using the same curriculum as the past two years. It is designed for remediation, not acceleration.

Mail-in registration is accepted for all levels.
